2. The TRUSTEES have at the request of SETTLORS agreed to act as TRUSTEES of these presents upon the terms and provisions contained.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH as follows:

1. In order to effectuate the said desire the Settlers have each made over to the Trustees a sum of Rs 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand) and in total Rs 21,000/- (Rupees Twenty One thousand),

The Trustees hereby declare that they and the survivors or survivor of them or other trustees hereof for the time being will hold the said sum of Rs 21,000/- made over by the Settlers to the Trustees as aforesaid and all addition and accretions thereto and accumulated income thereof and all further gifts and donations that may be received by the Trustees from time to time representing the same upon trust to apply the same for the objects and purposes expressed.


2. TRUST NAME

The name of the Trust shall be ^{S.} H.M.D. TRUST, with liberty to the Trustees to change the same.

3. OBJECTS

The objects for which the TRUST FUND is established are education, relief of the poor, medical relief and advancement of any other charitable objects of general public utility not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit and for such purpose:

(a) To establish, support, acquire, fund and/or grant aid and other financial assistance to schools, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, boarding houses, laboratories and other institutions of like nature at any place or places in the Indian Union for use of the students and staff and also generally for the development and/or advancement of education

- and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public in general.
- (b) To establish, maintain and/or run studentship, scholarships and render other kind of aid to individuals including supply of medicines, books, stipends, modals and other incentives to study without any distinction of caste, colour or creed.
- (c) To establish, maintain and/or grant aid in cash and/or in kind to hospitals, medicals, medical colleges, nursing institutions, senatoria, charitable and/or travelling dispensaries, after-care clinics, maternity houses, child welfare centres, orphanage, widow's homes.
- (d) To grant aid, to promote, establish, support and/or maintain institutions for the promotions of Science, Literature, Music, Drama, Fine Arts, for the preservation of old historical monuments and for the diffusion of useful knowledge through schools, colleges, laboratories, reading rooms, libraries, research and other institutions having the similar objects for the benefit of the public in ~~IXX~~ general.
- (e) To establish and/or grant aid for the establishment and maintainance of parks and gardens, gymnasime and sports, institutes, tubewells, wells and water works for supply of drinking water and for the construction of and/or repairs to wells for the use of public in ~~IXX~~ general.
- (f) To establish, maintain and grant aid to homes, orphanages or other establishments for relief and help to the needy, the poor and destitute peoples, orphans, and widows.
- (g) To render assistance and/or grant aid to recognised public charitable trusts or institutions.
- (h) To do any other act for the advancement of general public utility not involving the carrying on any activity for profit, without distinction of caste, colour and creed.

4. HEAD OFFICE

The Head Office of the trust shall be situated at JAIGAM unless changed by the Trustees.

5. ACCOUNTS

The TRUSTEES shall cause true and accurate accouts to be kept of all money received and spent and of all matters in respect ~~IXX~~ thereof in course of management of trust.

1. NUMBER OF TRUSTEES

The number of Trustees shall not be less than two and not more than thirty one.

2. CONTINUANCE OF MEMBERSHIP

All the Trustees unless they voluntarily resign or otherwise decide shall continue to be the Trustees during the term of their natural lives.


3. APPOINTMENT OF TRUSTEES

The power to appoint new or additional trustees but so far as not to exceed the maximum number and to fill up the vacancies in the office of the trustees, shall vest in the continuing Trustees.

4. POWER OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES

For the furtherance of the object of the Trust and in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, for investment or use of the trust funds, for the time being in force, the TRUSTEES will have the following powers :

- (a) To accept donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or in kind from any person, body of persons or trust.
- (b) To apply the whole or part of the income of the TRUST FUND or accumulation thereof or whole or part of the corpus of the Trust Fund for any one or more of the objects of the Trust as the TRUSTEES may in their discretion from time to time determine.
- (c) To convert and deal with the Trust Property and/or to carry the investments for the time being.
- (d) To invest and keep invested the TRUST FUND either in the purchase of mortgage or immovable or in shares, stock or debenture or other moveable properties.
- (e) To borrow or raise or secure payments of money and also

- (8) To lease, sell, either with or without security.
 - (9) To sell, dispose, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust Fund.
 - (10) To open account with any bank or banks and to operate such account through one or more of the trustees or by an agent appointed by the TRUSTEES.
 - (11) To appoint or make provision for the appointment of a sub-committee of trustees and/or others to attend to or to supervise or to conduct specified jobs or functions, in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the trustees may prescribe.
 - (12) To set apart the whole or part of the income or the corpus of the TRUST FUND or part thereof for any of the objects of the TRUST.

10. QUORUM

Five trustees at a meeting shall form a quorum for any meeting of the Board of Trustees, but if the total number of trustees on the date of meeting is less than five then the total number of trustees on such date shall form a quorum for the meeting.

11. CHAIRMAN

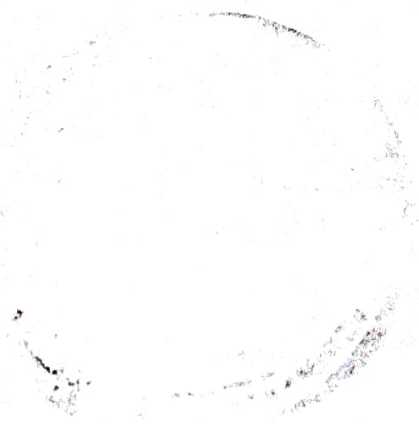
The trustees for the time being shall elect from amongst themselves one chairman and he shall hold office for one year unless he resigns or refuses to act as chairman or at any time ceases to be trustee.

12. RESOLUTION IN BOARD MEETINGS

In case of difference of opinion between the trustees, the opinion of majority shall prevail and if the trustees are equally divided in any matter, the chairman shall have a casting vote.

13. MEETINGS

All meetings of the trust shall be held at such place and at such time as the chairman of the trust shall decide from time to time.
